Authority

- Children can use authority as well as adults. A leader uses authority when working with others. In *I Am a Leader!* some actions are described which help make a good leader. What are three things you can do to be a good leader?
- A person in a position of authority needs to have confidence to be successful. After reading *I Am Confident!*, what are some things you know you can do with confidence?

Responsibility

- *I Am Responsible!* lists many responsibilities you may need to carry out each day. What benefit is described in the book that is a result of carrying out your responsibilities?
- When you make choices for yourself, you are being responsible. In *I'm in Charge of Me!*, what might happen if you did not choose to play nicely with others?
- After reading *I Can Make Good Choices!*, what two things did you learn you should do before making a choice?
- In *I Have Manners!* many examples of good manners are given. Do you think using good manners is a responsibility? Explain your answer.
- *I'm a Good Friend!* describes things you can do to be a good friend. These actions can also be responsibilities. What are some benefits of being a good friend? What are some costs?

Justice

- *I Tell the Truth!* is a book about being honest. Why do you think telling the truth is the fair thing to do?
- *I Care about Others!* describes some examples of helping others. Which examples have to do with distributive justice?
- In *I Am Generous!*, which actions deal with a sense of fairness?
