THREE TYPES OF JUSTICE

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Activity Description

This is an activity that helps students make connections between the three types of justice (corrective, distributive, and procedural). After studying *Foundations of Democracy, Justice* curriculum, students create a visual representation of the three types of justice. This activity allows students to review related vocabulary.

Suggested Grade Level

Estimated Time to Complete

Review activity (one class period)

Objectives

Students will

- create a visual representation to show their understanding of the three types of justice;
- explain their project during a presentation of information.

Materials Needed

- Two file folders for each student, glued together to form a tri-fold board
- Pictures that have been drawn or printed from the Internet
- Markers
- Glue
- Scissors

Activity Procedures

1. Give each student a prepared tri-fold folder mat.
2. Students may draw pictures on white paper to represent the three types of justice, or they may print pictures from the Internet to use.
3. Students should label the tri-fold sections with the headings Corrective, Procedural, and Distributive Justice.

4. Students should place pictures they have drawn or printed off the Internet under the correct heading.
5. Students should decorate each section and then write a short statement concerning each heading.
1. Finally, they write a summary statement to tie all three types of justice together.
